I am also delighted that the University has been selected as a Charter Member of the Athena Swan Program in Australia and is partnering with the Australian Academy of Science in a pilot project to promote the participation and retention of women in science, technology, engineering and mathematics and medicine (STEMM) disciplines.

We must continue to build a more inclusive workplace and encourage women to participate equally in every arena of university activity and at every level.
